- The student will present:
 - a. an essay of 300 words or less stating why he/she is worthy of this scholarship,
 - b. a letter from his/her high school showing an achievement of an 80% or greater cumulative average,
 - c. two(2) letters of support,
 - d. proof of acceptance into the College.

Scholarship Amount

The Superannuated Teachers of Saskatchewan (STS) Prince Albert Chapter Scholarship will be awarded in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500).
