<u>How to get to Redberry Bible Camp:</u> Take Highway #12 north from Saskatoon toward Blaine Lake. After crossing Petrofka Bridge, take the first left hand turn at the top of the hill. It is marked with a sign for Redberry Bible Camp. Follow the signs on the grid roads to reach the camp.
